Dear Parents and Caregivers:

In preparation for the **2017-2018** school year, this letter is to inform you of the immunization requirements for school attendance for children entering the 6th grade.

State law requires students 11 years of age or who are entering the 6th grade to show proof of having received a second dose of Varicella (Chickenpox) vaccine, one dose of Tdap (Tetanus, Diphtheria, and Acellular Pertussis) vaccine, and one dose of MCV4 (Meningococcal) vaccine.

For information regarding immunization requirements, please refer to the State of Louisiana Immunization Law R.S.17:170. Additionally, immunization information can be obtained on the Louisiana Immunization Network for Kids Statewide (LINKS) website.
